

FEES & TUITION 2009

Tuition costs for each workshop are \$1152.00* for 3 undergraduate credits, and \$1224.00* for 3 graduate credits. The Bursar's office will provide you with the schedule for payment when you register on-line for these workshops. *Fees may be subject to change by the action of the University Board of Trustees.

In addition, you are responsible for the special course fee for art materials, \$22.00 per credit hour for Fine Art workshops (printmaking, painting, sculpture) and \$25.00 per credit hour for Crafts workshops (ceramics jewelry/metals, textiles, glass). Applicants will be notified immediately of any changes or additional costs.

Partial or full scholarships/fee waivers will be awarded based on portfolio review. All applications will be reviewed for scholarships.

Applications must be received by 24 April, 2009 Jewelry/Metals, Painting, and Sculpture.

Applications must be received by 8 May, 2009 for Ceramics and Textiles.

PLEASE NOTE

An additional non-Ohio resident fee of \$338.00 per credit hour is waived if you enroll for these workshops only during the summer. However, if you are enrolled in coursework other than workshops, the additional non-Ohio resident fee is applicable for all credit coursework and credit workshops.
